Grievance - Reviews complaints alleging a violation of a membership, Code of Ethics or MLS duty to determine whether or not the complaint should be forwarded to the Professional Standards Committee for hearing. **MUST COMPLETE PROFESSIONAL STANDARDS TRAINING**

Legislative/Local Government—Recommends and coordinates actions relating to statewide and nationwide legislation through C.A. R. and N.A.R. Promotes private ownership of real property by encouraging favorable legislation.

Long Range Planning - Assure the most effective and efficient allocation of Association resources, develops strategic long range plan which focuses on results to be achieved, ties activities to objectives.

Membership - Reviews membership, recommends rules and procedures to BOD. Assures growth and quality of membership through member benefits.

Multiple Listing Service (MLS) - Recommends MLS policies, procedures, Rules and Regulations through Board of Directors to CRMLS: oversees the MLS procedures and monitors/implements the MLS Rules and Regulations.

Professional Standards - Provides panelists for disciplinary or arbitration hearings in accordance with the Professional Standards Rules **MUST COMPLETE PROFESSIONAL STANDARDS TRAINING**

Public Relations - Plan and promote a variety of projects and events related to real estate for members: to promote community involvement through projects designed to educate and build community awareness: to promote East Valley AOR and its members.

Young Professionals Network - Help young real estate practitioners become more business savvy by hosting regular networking events, communicating with other YPN members, and sharing tips and tricks.
